So, in case your country has not already provided the structured feedback, there is now a window of opportunity to do so. The deadline for this additional feedback is May 10. Please get in touch with us if you wish to provide feedback to any of the five GLASS technical documents, to be included in the final reports. The documents as well as the feedback templates are found in the GLASS2020 platform (accessible from www.glass2020.org).
