

# Public health preparedness during Prayagraj Maha Kumbh 2025



- Public Health Federated Structure
- State Govt notifies Kumbh area as a district
- Temporary Administrative structure identified for public health implementation



#### **Event Characteristics**

- Showcased as a mega event of faith and culture
- Site: River floodplain
- Duration: 45 days
- Type of visitors: Long duration and floating
- Ritual of bathing in river
- Five major days of significance

### Public health preparedness during Prayagraj Maha Kumbh 2025

### **Temporary health facilities: 23**

- One Central Hospital (100 beds)
- Two Zonal Hospitals (25 beds)
- Four Sector Hospitals (20 beds)
- First Aid Points
- Diagnostic Lab
- >150 free essential drugs
- Linkage to four govt. tertiary hospitals

Private hospitals identified for surge capacity/ green

corridor



#### **Water and Sanitation**

- Piped drinking water/ Water quality monitoring
- Temporary toilets > 45,000 with removable septic tanks/soak pits
- Sewage disposal weekly
- Dustbins >25,000
- Sanitation workers- 15,000

#### **Vector Control**

#### Pre-event

- Environmental
  - Solid waste management
  - Potential breeding sources
- Chemical
  - IRS temporary dwellings

#### During event

- Vector surveillance
- Antilarval and antiadult measures
  - Fogging and indoor space sprays
- Early detection and treatment strengthened
  After event
- Vector surveillance to continue
- Chemical methods

Disease surveillance during a large religious mass gathering in India: The Prayagraj Kumbh 2019 experience



Disease Surveillance built on 2019 public health legacy of implementing a surveillance system



- For 25 syndromes/disease conditions
- Special surveillance module in digital platform
- Event-based/aggregate
- Case-based for lab confirmed cases
- Training, monitoring and event verification by NCDC officers
- Implementation by state government
- Community surveillance module

### Innovations: Environmental Surveillance and Respiratory Disease monitoring

# AQI data monitored: Ministry of Environment

- PM 10
- PM 2.5
- O3
- NOX
- SOX

#### Health Conditions monitored:

- Influenza like illness
- Acute Exacerbation of Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease
- Acute Exacerbation of Asthma
- Respiratory health condition and AQI data linked to assess acute health impact
- AQI data used for risk communication to visitors esp vulnerable population such as eldery, pregnant and those with chronic illness





# **Innovations: Screening for Tuberculosis**

- India committed to global efforts on tuberculosis elimination
- Kumbh mass gathering leveraged for new case detection through tuberculosis screening camps among visitors
- Use of technology for rapid case detection:
  - TrueNat
  - Al for rapid interpreting X rays
- Identified cases linked to treatment
