

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Data Verification

- 1) the domain of estimation—or the level of the health system for which estimates of data quality (i.e. accuracy, completeness, etc.) are needed;
- 2) the number of stratifiers— that is, levels of different variables for which distinct estimates are needed, e.g. type of facility, and management authority; and
- 3) the level of precision desired on estimates and the acceptable margin of error.

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
