WHY IS THIS



or 1 billion children suffer some form of violence each year



Violence has many immediate & lifelong consequences on physical & mental health, risk-taking behaviours & overall quality of life



Violence against women often co-occurs with violence against children



Health systems play a critical role in prevention & response to violence against children



Equip health service providers with the necessary skills to address violence against children







Strengthen implementation of legislative frameworks and evidence-based programmes consistent with the INSPIRE framework



Designate a focal point within Ministries of Health to ensure coordination





Prioritize data collection & monitoring

Include children, as appropriate, in advocacy, policy development & action



Support, in particular, children in humanitarian settings, children with disabilities & others who are vulnerable



Allocate the necessary budget for national policies and plans



**Enhance international** cooperation





Enhancing capacity within WHO's regional and country offices



Providing technical support to Ministries of Health



Supporting nationally representative surveys on violence against children



**Documenting progress** in countries



**Facilitating** knowledge exchange
