International Health Regulations (2005) (IHR) Review Committee regarding Standing Recommendations for COVID-19

Terms of Reference

The IHR Review Committee regarding Standing Recommendations for COVID-19 is convened by the Director-General of the World Health Organization (WHO) pursuant to *Chapter III – The Review Committee* of the IHR (Articles 50-53).

This Review Committee will function in accordance with the WHO Regulations for Expert Advisory Panels and Committees.¹

Pursuant to Article 50.1(b),² this Review Committee will **provide its views and technical** advice to the Director-General with respect to Standing Recommendations for COVID-19, as proposed by the Director-General.

Since this is the first time that a Review Committee is convened pursuant to Article 50.1(b), it is understood that further details in support of these Terms of Reference may be provided as experience is gained.
