
## Homelessness Some key stats

- 700.000 people in EU (+ UK)
  - Street & shelter
  - 0.14% of population
  - 70% increase in 10 years
  - Increase also in countries with strong social welfare systems
  - Prevalence millions per year
  - « Chronification »

#### Homelessness & health

- Most homeless people are sick
  - Physical & mental health problems
  - NCD & infectious diseases
  - Dynamic relation health homelessness
  - Undiagnosed problems
  - Wealth of research
    - Too little impact on policies & services
- Access to health care system is complicated
  - Insurance & Stigma & Affordability & Needs
  - Ineffective use of health care
    - E&A
  - Parrallel system of health care
    - Irrespective of universal nature of health care system, NGO are main health care providers...
  - Link health & social care systems problematic
    - Hospital discharge into homelessness...
- Homeless is key health inequity issue
  - Average of death of chronically homeless < 50</li>
    - Lower for women

### Housing as a « treatment » to homelessness

- Homelessness is housing & (public) health issue
  - Resistance from homeless « sector »
- Shelter makes people sick
  - 20% excess commorbidity
- Housing First
  - New approach
  - Works
    - Housing stability 80% to 95%
    - Health but addiction...
    - Costs important savings in health sector
  - HF as health intervention
    - Tap into health budgets
- Prevention of homelessness
  - Spike in health care use before people become homeless
    - Mobilise GPs in prevention programmes

## Housing = strong determinant of health

- Beyond « traditional » determinants like food, smoking, air pollution....
  - Often overlooked
- WHO Europe research 2019
  - 1% GDP more investment in housing reduces health equity gap by 2%
  - 3 times more effective than increased investment in social protection or health
  - Lets start with homelessness!
- Corona crisis & homelessness
  - Infections with delay
  - Impossible measures for homeless people
  - No priority for vaccination
  - Housing best protection against pandemic also for homeless
  - Moratoria on evictions
    - CDC
