## EBS Tools in Uganda

#### Unstructured reports from the community

- eIDSR
- U-report
- mTrac anonymous reports

#### Internet-based Scanning

- TweetDeck
- Google Alerts set up to the PHEOC email
- Traditional Internet scanning using ProMed, HealthMap, WHO Bulletin, GPHIN, etc.
- Alerts from WhatsApp and email surveillance groups

#### Phones calls

- MoH Call centre and PHEOC toll-free lines
- Direct Phone calls to MoH IES / PHEOC Staff from community / health workers

#### Other Sources

- Laboratory reports
- Radio and TV listsening
- Personal Walkins to the PHEOC

## Unstructured reports from the community: eIDSR

• A home-grown system, based on the DHIS2 architecture. eIDRS is our electronic surveillance system.

• Among other functions, it enables community and health workers send unstructured alerts using the 6767 short code on their phones

 Alerts are received at national level by a few selected staff, who then triage, validate and decide on the necessary course of action according SOP



## Unstructured reports from the community: U-Report

- A UNICEF-supported system, spread out to community volunteers including VHTs and health workers
- Volunteers use phones to text a range of health issues, including surveillance / suspect outbreak/threats.



## Unstructured reports from the community: mTrac

 A UNICEF-supported system, primarily focusing on Indicator Based Surveillance (IBS)

 members to report about a range of
 health-based matters, including
 surveillance / suspected outbreaks.



## Online Scanning: ProMed, HealthMap, WHO Bulletin, etc

 MoH PHEOC as login access to GPHIN and ProMed

 Health Map and WHO Outbreaks bulletin are also scanned regularly



## Online Scanning: Professional Social Networks

 All MoH Surveillance staff are part of health-based social networks for surveillance

 Tools include WhatApp groups, email groups, among others.

#### Phone Calls

EBS signals also come through phone calls

 Sometimes health workers call surveillance officials at the national level directly on their private cell-phone contacts



#### Other EBS Sources

- Laboratory Reports
  - All regional and national laboratories are linked to the PHEOC.

Listening to Radios, watching Television

Individual Walk-ins / Call-ins from Subject
 Matter Experts and partners in community-based surveillance

## EBS in Uganda – Current Challenges/ Gaps / Needs

- Sources of information are overwhelming listed 40 sources (?Prioritize), some repeat same message
- Need to formally establish an EBS Unit at the MoH PHEOC
  - We need to recruit staff for EBS -- in process
  - We also need tools) to formalize the EBS outputs (Update EBS SOP)
- Need to conduct the Text-to-speech for radio and/or TV Scanning for surveillance signals --- A green light from WHO country office

Build one EBS system for OH platform (substantive support required)

- Become linked to the EIOS tool
  - The Ministry has committed in writing to participate in pilot project.
