

# Registration update - countries or areas



As of **4 May 2020**, a total of **23 564** hospitals and health-care facilities in **184 countries** or areas have registered their commitment to hand hygiene as part of the global campaign – SAVE LIVES: Clean Your Hands.

This map of the world (last updated in May 2020) helps you see how registrations are progressing and highlights number of health-care facilities registered for SAVE LIVES: Clean Your Hands, adjusted by population per country.
