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Decision WHA74(11)

WHO Member States decided:

(1) to **extend the current TORs of the GCM until 2030** with a mid-term evaluation in 2025;

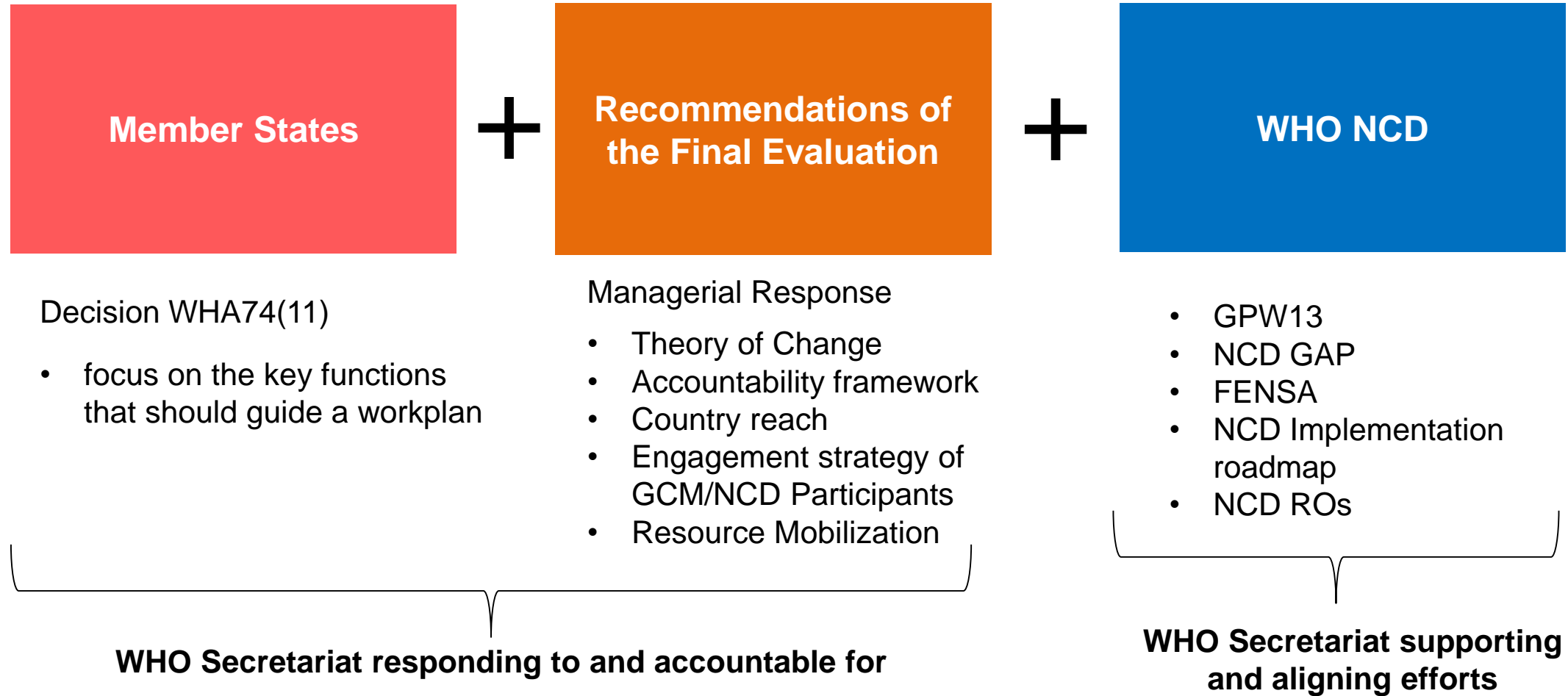
(2) to request the Director-General:

(a) to ensure the continued performance of GCM and its functions, with **a more focused approach to the delivery of its functions, and with clearly defined objectives and measurable and practical milestones** that ensure that the work of the GCM contributes to the achievement of the objectives set in the WHO Global NCD Action Plan 2013-2030

(b) to develop, **in consultation with Member States and NSAs, a workplan for the GCM**, to be submitted to the WHA75 and to present the work undertaken and results achieved so far by the GCM to Member States and NSAs in 2022 in order to receive their further guidance on the implementation of the workplan

(c) to ensure that the GCM carries out its functions in a way that is **integrated with the WHO's ongoing work on NCDs**

Guiding the GCM/NCD Workplans

1

An operational backbone for knowledge collaboration and the dissemination of innovative multistakeholder responses at country level, by co-creating, enhancing and disseminating evidence-based information to support governments on effective multisectoral and multistakeholder approaches

2

An enabler for the global stocktaking of multistakeholder action at country level and for co-designing and scaling up innovative approaches, solutions or initiatives to strengthen effective multisectoral and multistakeholder action

3

Providing and updating guidance to Member States on engagement with non-State actors, including on the prevention and management of potential risks

4

A global facilitator for the strengthened capacity of Member States and civil society to develop national multistakeholder responses for NCDs

5

A convener of civil society, including PLWNCDs, to raise awareness and build capacity for their meaningful participation in national NCD responses

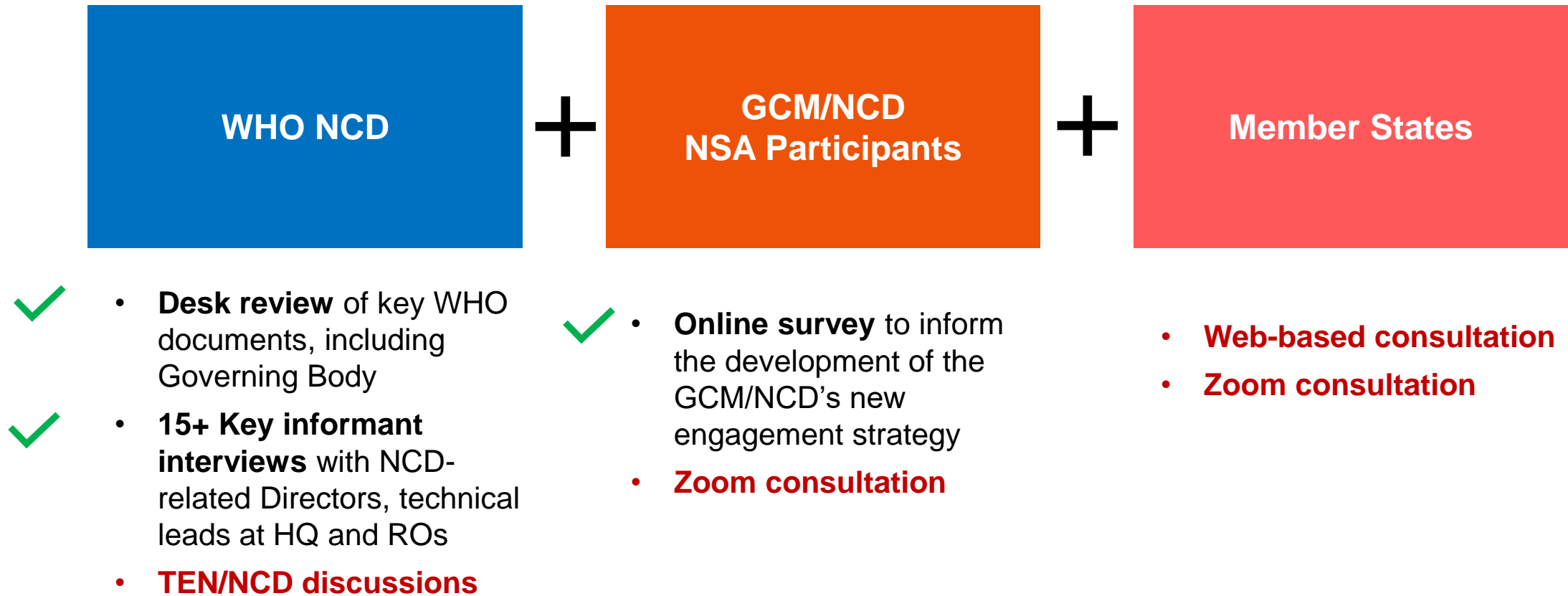

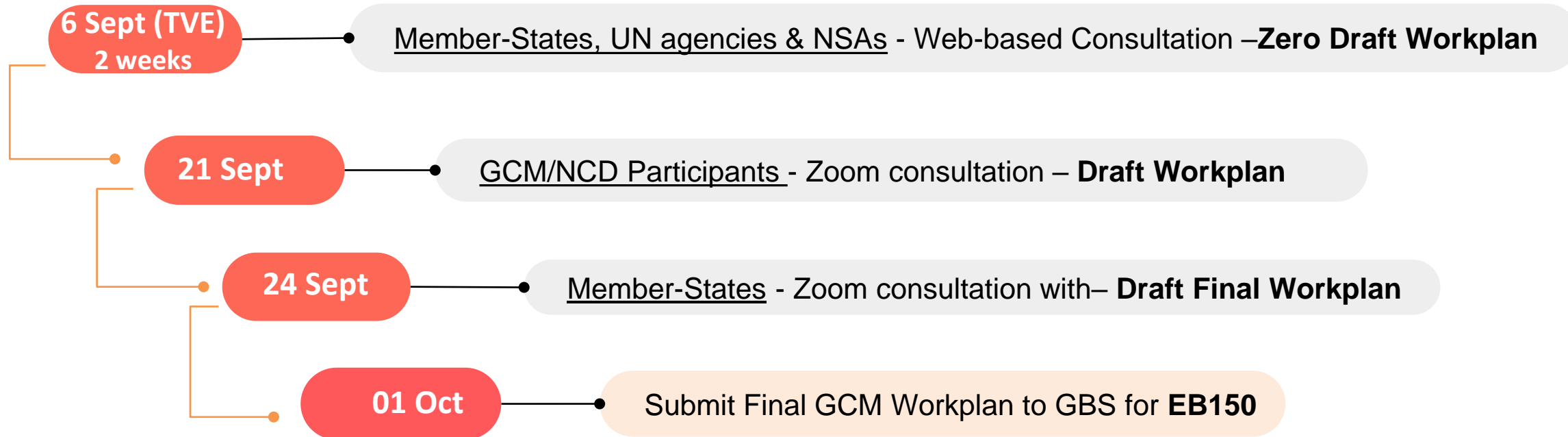
