





### **Driving Convergence: National quality policy & strategy**

#### Why now?

- Many countries currently reviewing national policy/health sector plans in light of SDG/UHC 2030 agenda – <u>timely</u>.
- Each country will require specific tools and support to allow for tailored solutions based on need and priorities <u>country specificity</u>.

#### Why focus on quality policy and strategy?

- Catalyze and organize national efforts drive <u>convergence</u> of effort!
- Secure high level <u>commitment</u> for quality.
- Ensure partner <u>alignment</u>.


#### How can quality policy and strategy be developed?

- Mandate from national leadership.
- Active engagement of multiple stakeholders in <u>co-development</u>.
- Grounded in local definition, analysis & priorities.
- <u>Cross-country</u> technical exchange.




### **Implementation Driving Policy & Strategy:**

### National Quality Policy & Strategy – The Essence






### **Looking ahead – WHO NQPS**
