Gaps in services are widespread:

270M unmet
contraception need.

73M abortions
every year, half of
these are unsafe.

1 in 3 women
experienced physical
or sexual violence.

800
pregnancy-related
deaths every day.

500M women and girls without
access to services and products to manage
menstruation.

1M+ sexually
transmitted infections
acquired every day.

1 in 6 people
experience infertility
in their lifetime.

Impacting lives

Invest in people: US\$ 10.60 per person annually would provide multiple health, social and economic benefits including:



68% decrease in unintended pregnancies

72% decrease in unsafe abortions

62% decrease in maternal deaths

to exercise their **sexual** and
reproductive rights.

More girls in **schools**,
and women in the **labour**
market.

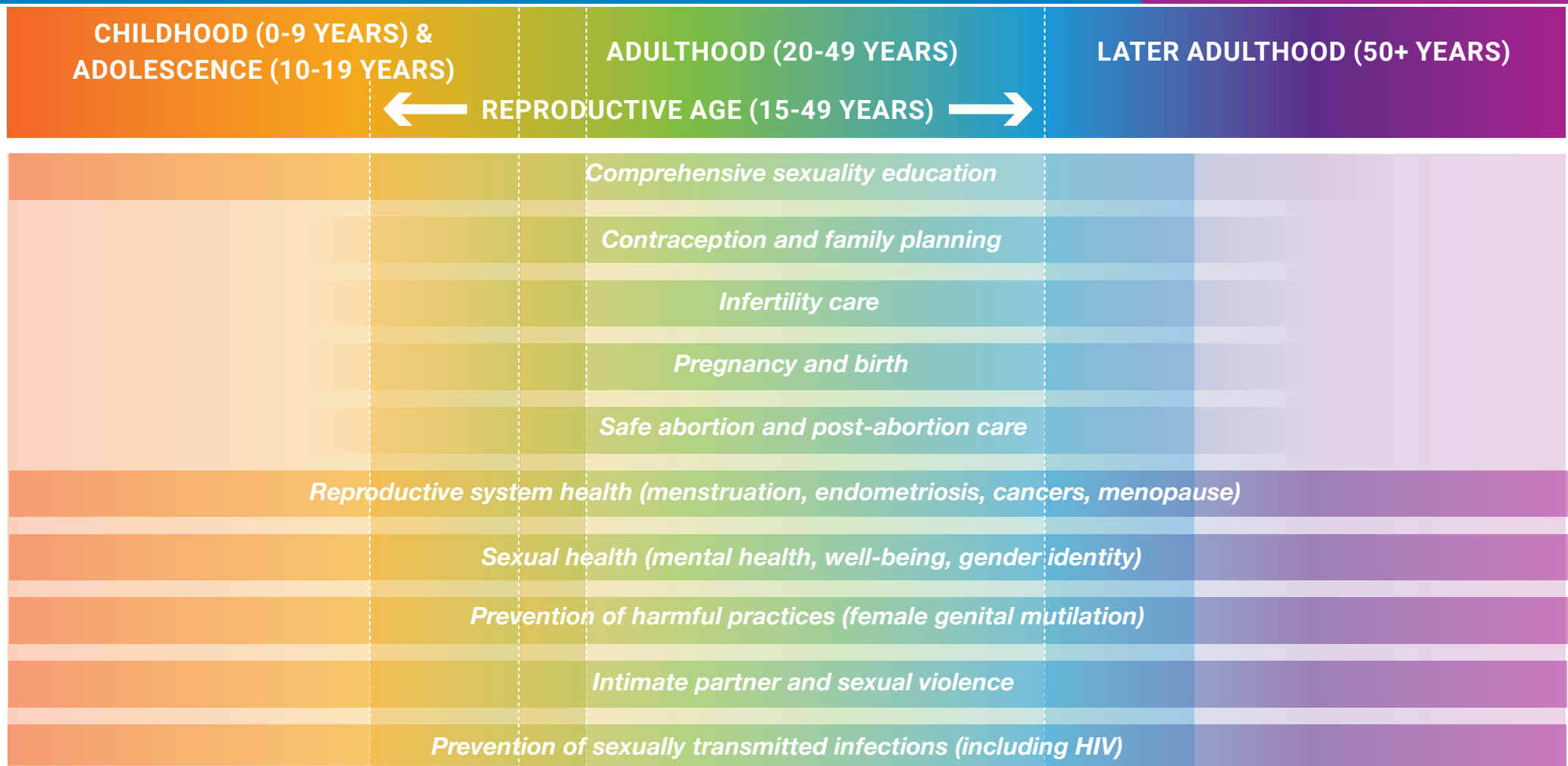


This requires both international donors and domestic governments to significantly **step up** their
