### Shuttle/transportation services from the hotel to the venue





- Upon arrival at the airport, please contact the **Hotel booth or the person holding your hotel signage in the arrival area** (after you passed immigration and picked up your luggage) to take you to your hotel.
- Shuttle services have been arranged to transport the participants from the respective hotels to AUC and return to the hotels after the conference sessions.
- On 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> February morning, the **departure time for shuttle services for the transfer to the conference venue is set at 07:30 AM.** Please be at the hotel reception ready for departure at 07:30 AM.
- In case there is a need, taxis can be taken but we recommend that they
  be arranged with the hotel beforehand. The cost is about Birr 150 one
  way.
- You are advised not to take public transportation to get to the Conference venue.
- Self-funded (non-sponsored delegates by organizers) are responsible for booking and paying for their own accommodation and all related costs during their stay in Addis Ababa.

# Weather



Addis Ababa is situated at 2,324 m or 7,625 feet above sea level. It has a humid sub-tropical mild summer climate. During daylight hours in February temperature the expected maximum temperature is 23°C and at night the minimum is 10°C. It will stay partly sunny. ### Security



- Be on alert for handbag, laptop and cellular phone snatchers and pickpockets or suspicious looking persons. Remember crime awareness beats crime.
- Deposit valuable property with hotel management or in hotel safes when going out of the hotel room.
- Do not travel with expensive valuables or too much cash.
- Avoid travelling alone.
- Participants are required to visibly wear conference badges at the venue at all times

### Currencies: Exchange rate, and Forex



- The local currency is Ethiopian Birr (ETB) and is used for transactions across the country. The US Dollar (US\$), Euro and British Pound are the most easily convertible foreign currencies in Ethiopia. 1 USD = 28.38 ETB (rates may vary).
- Money can be changed from US Dollar, Euro and British pound to ETB at the airport, in banks, as well as in hotels that have foreign exchange bureaux.



- Many Hotels in Addis Ababa will accept ETB, Visa, MasterCard, and U.S dollar cash payments.
- You are required to declare cash of USD 3,000 or more upon arrival at the Addis Ababa Airport.
- Please note that before leaving Ethiopia you should convert all your Ethiopian Birr, since it cannot be used anywhere else. Changing money from Ethiopian Birr to foreign currency is only possible upon the presentation of a passport and an airplane ticket.
