Evdokia Moise is senior trade policy analyst in the Emerging Policy Issues Division of the Trade and Agriculture Directorate, Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), in Paris. She is responsible for the OECD work in the area of trade facilitation and for the trade policy reviews of countries in the process of accession to the OECD.

She joined the OECD in 1990 and has worked on a variety of international trade policy issues in support of WTO discussions and negotiations, including regulatory issues affecting market openness and trade, trade and environment, intellectual property protection, regional trade agreements, and technical barriers to trade. Before joining the OECD, Evdokia Moise worked in a private law firm in Athens. She holds a Master's of Law Degree from the University of Athens and a DEA of International Law from Paris II University.

In the context of her work on trade facilitation, Evdokia Moise has elaborated the OECD Trade Facilitation Indicators, identified and analysed good governance practices adopted by OECD and non-OECD countries in implementing trade facilitation, and conducted an assessment of costs and challenges incurred by developing countries in implementing trade facilitation measures under negotiation.
