Guilherme Antonio da Costa Júnior is a Veterinary Doctor at the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Food Supply of Brazil. He has been Chairperson of the Codex Alimentarius Commission since 2017 and was Agricultural Attaché in the Mission of Brazil to the WTO in Geneva from 2010 to 2014.

Guilherme da Costa graduated in Veterinary Medicine in Brazil and specialized in Food Quality Assurance in Japan. He worked in food safety in Brazil for 35 years and was Director of the Department of SPS Negotiations of the Ministry of Agriculture. He also spent 15 years as a FAO and WHO consultant in projects related to SPS issues in different countries of the Americas and Africa, as well as participating in STDF activities in Geneva and Africa.
