Dra. Reri Indriani, Apt., M.Si. was born in Jakarta on May 27, 1963, she obtained Bachelor of Pharmacy degree and Pharmacist profession degree at the University of Indonesia. Furthermore, she obtained Master in Communication Science from The London School of Public Relations - Jakarta.

She officially served as Permanent Inspector of the National Agency of Drug and Food Control (NADFC) of the Republic of Indonesia (Indonesia FDA) since 9 February 2018 and since 14 August 2018 she was appointed as Acting Deputy Chairperson of Drug, Narcotic, Psychotropic, Precursor, and Addictive Substance Control. Previously she served as the Permanent Secretary of NADFC in 2014-2018, served as the Head of the Drug and Food Information Center in 2010-2014 and Director of Product Standardization Therapies and Household Products in 2008-2010.

She had a number of achievements, i.e. for bringing NADFC to obtain the sixth of e-Transparency Award 2013 for the Ministry/Institution Body Category and in the same year carrying NADFC as the first rank of Indonesian e-Government (PEGI awards) LPNK category. In addition, she also brought NADFC to obtain ISO 27001 Information Security Management System certification.

In cross-linkage sector, she actively participates in national committees including being the Chair of the IAI Cooperation and Partnership Division in 2014-2016, being a member of the National Team for the Prevention of Intellectual Property Rights (PPHKI National Team), member of the National Team for International Trade Protection (PPI National Team), KFN member (National Pharmacy Committee) since 2014 until now. For her dedication, the state has awarded the Satya Lencana Karya Satya XX years from the President of the Republic of Indonesia.
