Simon is an expert in applying data science and technologies to agricultural systems and natural resource management. An internationally accomplished scientist, Simon is a strategic thinker with over 25 years' experience leading research programs across the world, including within the CSIRO and the CGIARs. He was part of the groups pioneering precision agriculture within Australian grains, wine and sugar industries which produced the first yield maps for these crops. Simon now leads the Sustainable Food Systems research program, as part of the national Collaborative Research Centre for Food Agility, focusing on the opportunities and obstacles of applying digital technologies. Simon is also the inaugural Premier's Fellow in Agriculture and Food of Western Australia.
