12.1 Chemical contaminants in drinking-water

1,1-Dichloroethane

History of guideline development

The 1958, 1963 and 1971 WHO *International Standards for Drinking-water* and the first edition of the *Guidelines for Drinking-water Quality*, published in 1984, did not refer to 1,1-dichloroethane. In view of the very limited database on toxicity and carcinogenicity, the 1993 Guidelines concluded that no guideline value for 1,1-dichloroethane should be proposed. This assessment was brought forward to the third edition of the Guidelines, published in 2004, and the fourth edition of the Guidelines, published in 2011.
