12.1 Chemical contaminants in drinking-water

Sodium dichloroisocyanurate

History of guideline development

Sodium dichloroisocyanurate was not considered in the WHO *International Standards for Drinking-water* or in the first or second editions of the WHO *Guidelines for Drinking-water Quality*. In the second addendum to the third edition, published in 2008, guideline values of 50 mg/l as sodium dichloroisocyanurate and 40 mg/l as cyanuric acid were established. These guideline values were brought forward to the fourth edition of the Guidelines, published in 2011.
